• To provide children with reading, writing, listening and speaking skills in another language. • To open their mind to a world wider than their own. • To develop and introduce a different culture, traditions and beliefs. • To use another language in everyday context. • To provide the children with a curriculum that has breadth, depth and balance. • To give the children a love of travel and the world	• Children in Class 2 (Y2/3) will receive one 30-45 minute session of French teaching per week. • Children in Class 3 (Y4/5/6) will receive one 45-60 minute session of German teaching per week. • The resources provided by the scheme of work help support teachers in their planning and delivery and contain sound clips, videos and games. • The themes covered allow for progression year on year and also link to national and international events. • Lessons allow for creativity through the use of song, role play, art and games. • Language should be embedded in the classroom, e.g. the register, displaying the date and classroom displays.	• Feedback from the children about their experience. • An increased love of the world and different cultures. • An increase in respect and understanding for the wider world in which we live. • Transition into MFL for the next stage of their education. • Develop their cultural capital and give them opportunities for a bright, successful future.
